Berserker - Tomás de Torquemada

The phrase is simple, spoken a hundred thousand times.

"Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live."

And thus, he did not.

From 1483 to 1498, Tomás de Torquemada presided over the Spanish Inquisition, the notorious Catholic tribunal used to try heretics and nonbelievers. In order to force their confession, these victims were subjected to gruesome punishments including strangulation or being stretched on the rack. Others were waterboarded or put through strappado, a grueling torture in which subjects were hanged by their wrists until their arms dislocated.

A Franciscan monk, Torquemada was the man responsible for reorganizing the Inquisition and expanding its scope to include crimes like blasphemy, usury and even sorcery. Torquemada also ordered the expulsion of thousands of Jews, Muslims and blacks, all of whom he believed would taint the spiritual purity of Spain. Those that converted to Christianity were allowed to remain but risked being tortured or executed if they tried to practice their faith in secret. All told, some 2,000 people were murdered during Torquemada's reign as Grand Inquisitor, most of them beheaded or burned at the stake.

Mad Enhancement

SP: 7 RANK: EX

The insanity of Tomás is all-encompassing, his sheer fanaticism is unassailable in its purity. Tomás madness exudes like an aura, infecting others around him with his faith in the glory of God. It taints his very being, as his view of God, of God's love is so twisted and warped it could scarcely be called 'love' any longer.

False Divinity SP: 4 (11) RANK: B

Is it delusion, when reality itself agrees with it? Tomás is a 'false' saint, a faker so truthful to his belief that the world considers it to be true. While he may not be divine, his God's blessing infects him like a virus, a festering burst of divinity that is not divine.

Magic Resistance

SP: 7 (18) RANK: EX

Magic is nothing to the glory of God.

Territory Conversion

SP: 4 (22) RANK: B

Tomás is not able to create territory, but to *convert* it. Any ground his feet touch is, naturally, the land of God. Tomás is capable of twisting magical artifacts when he is nearby.

Battle Continuation

SP: 3 (25) RANK: C

Tomás is willing to end magic by any means, even beyond the grave. Magic itself - must it be utilized in the pursuit of its own destruction - is something that must be suffered until it can no longer be suffered. To continue is to end the existence of this twisted world, that allows sorcerers to roam free.

Noble Phantasms

Rank C

Witches are naturally afraid of fire. As such, it is only natural that their enemy would wield it with gusto. Tomás burned many witches for many crimes - all of them varied and more insidious than the last.
