

HMH Module Pacing Guidance

The following guidance is suggested when considering how to pace and prioritize the program structure of Into Reading and Into Literature. The examples provided are intended for general informational and planning purposes.

Module Pacing

Current module/unit pacing suggests **4 weeks (Kindergarten)**, **3 weeks (Grades 1-5)**, and **6-8 weeks (Grades 6-8)** per module/unit.

Guidelines:

- Address SEL
- Explicit instruction of Notice and Note Signposts
- Progress monitor student learning with curriculum based assessments
 - Administer Weekly and Module Assessments (ES)
 - Practice and Apply Vocabulary and Grammar Assessment, Selection Tests and Unit Tests (MS)
- Administer District Diagnostic and Benchmark Assessments
 - Adhere to testing windows
- Test Sophistication (Grades 3-8) occurs alongside (not in place of) curriculum during small group instruction
- Maximize instructional time throughout the year taking into consideration trips and activities
- Ensure district deadlines are met for data analysis

Module Prioritization:

- All the standards/skills are cyclical throughout the scope and sequence and each additional exposure increases the complexity of text in which students apply the learning.
