August 2025 - With her new single “*Feeling the Heat*”, **Romi O** dives deep into the charged space where lust, love, and loss collide. The song is a vivid summer anthem - pulsing with passion, shimmering with euphoria, and shadowed by the heartbreak of realizing a fiery connection may not have been as mutual as it seemed. Emerging from months of emotional hibernation, the track embodies the rebirth that comes with seizing life, love, and carnal desire.

Musically, “*Feeling the Heat*” is a kaleidoscope of sound. Layers of bright synths, urgent rhythms, and Romi O’s commanding vocals create a sonic landscape that is both ecstatic and haunting. Echoes of **Charli XCX**, **Robyn**, **Kate Bush**, and **Lady Gaga** can be felt in the production, but the fearless genre-blending is uniquely Romi O.

Known for her signature approach - what she calls “**ADHD Music**” - Romi O fuses the genres she loves into vibrant and eclectic soundscapes that mirror her dynamic personality. Her artistry thrives on dualities: alt-rock intensity colliding with folk-like intimacy, pop euphoria balanced by lyrical vulnerability.

At once nuanced and explosive, her music is deeply relatable yet bold enough to stand apart. Romi O is the kind of artist who embraces difficult topics without flinching, allowing her audience to connect with her on a raw, human level.

“I’ve written so many sad ballads”, Romi O reflects. **“But I’m tired of being blue. I wanted to burn. I wanted to dance. And I wanted other people to dance too - even if the song comes from heartbreak”.** That fire burns throughout *“Feeling the Heat”*, especially in the refrain that asks the aching question: *“Was it only in my mind?”*

“Feeling the Heat” isn’t just a song - it’s an invitation to surrender to the pulse of passion, the sting of heartbreak, and the joy of dancing through it all.

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
