



# NFA Game Day Fan Guide

## Instructions for Attending NFA Sporting Events

It's Game Day! We are excited to welcome home and visiting teams and their fans to our various athletic event spaces. Below, you will find information that will help you navigate your arrival and enjoy the event.

**TEAM SCHEDULES** | All schedules for NFA sporting events can be found by [clicking this link](#).

**STREAMING** | All games on Academy Field and games in the main gym at NFA Main Campus will be streamed here: [HUDL Fan Livestream Site](#)

**PARKING** | Parking is available in the main parking lots of each school building and street parking following local law.

**ENTRY** | Entry directions vary depending on sport, season, and event location. Please read below for more details.

### Outdoor Events on Academy Field

**NFA Student Entry** | Gold Gym entrance on South Street

**Middle and Elementary School Students** | Must be accompanied by their parent/guardian and enter with them at the South Street gate (on top of the hill by the hut)

**Home Team Fans** | South Street gate (on top of the hill by the hut)

**Visiting Team (Players and coaches)** | South Street Academy Field arch entrance (across from Valley Ave.)

**Visiting Team Fans** | South Street Academy Field arch entrance (across from Valley Avenue)

### Indoor Events at NFA Main Campus

All entry is through the main entrance of NFA Main Campus (through the pillars). **There is no re-entry to any event.**

### BAG POLICY | No bags are permitted in the event. This includes, but is not limited to:

- All Bags: paper bags, plastic bags, ziplock baggies, Clear Bags, Pocketbooks, Cell Phone Cross Body Bags, Diaper Bags, Fanny Packs, Waist Bags, Belt bags, Backpacks, Camera Bags, Chromebook Cases.

**GENERAL SAFETY** | General safety protocols are in place for the safety of our athletes, fans, faculty, staff, and community supporters.

- Security personnel, law enforcement, and event staff are on-site in various locations to help provide a safe and secure event;
- Spectators are encouraged to remain in their seats when restrooms and concessions are not being visited;
- Every attendee, except for school personnel, must be in the stands. No standing or lingering in areas outside of the stands;
- There is no re-entry. Once a spectator has left the event, they will not be admitted back inside;
- Capacity Rules will be strictly enforced;
- Admittance is on a first-come, first-served basis;
- Event doors open an hour before the event unless otherwise specified;
- NFA student entry closes once the event space is at capacity and/or by the end of the 1st Quarter; All other entries close at Halftime (or another specified time limit based on the event), whichever comes first

### TICKETS | **There is no re-entry to any event.**

**NFA Students** | Pre-ticket sales for eligible NFA students; Students must provide ID to attend

**General Fan Admission** | Admittance is on a first-come, first-served basis. NFA student entry closes once the event space is at capacity and/or by the end of the 1st Quarter; All other entries close at Halftime (or another specified time limit based on the event), whichever comes first

**PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY** | Photos and videos are permitted from the stands. Those wishing enhanced access to the field sidelines, pool deck, courtside, mat side, etc. can submit a [Media Pass Request here](#). Non-staff and/or non-credentialed media requesting passes must also complete and submit pages 7-8 of the [NECSD Volunteer Manual](#).

**REMINDER TO FANS** | Our fans represent our student-athletes and our community. There is always a likelihood that scouts are in the stands to recruit our athletes for collegiate opportunities. We each hold a responsibility to positively represent our athletes to help amplify our scholars toward reaching their goals! Our fans in the stands should always be respectful and uplifting of our athletes, without directing negativity at our opponent. We each play a critical role in supporting our athletes and acting as role models for our community!

We ask that all fans be respectful of our event spaces and school grounds and take any trash or discarded items with you when you go.
