

DEFINITION

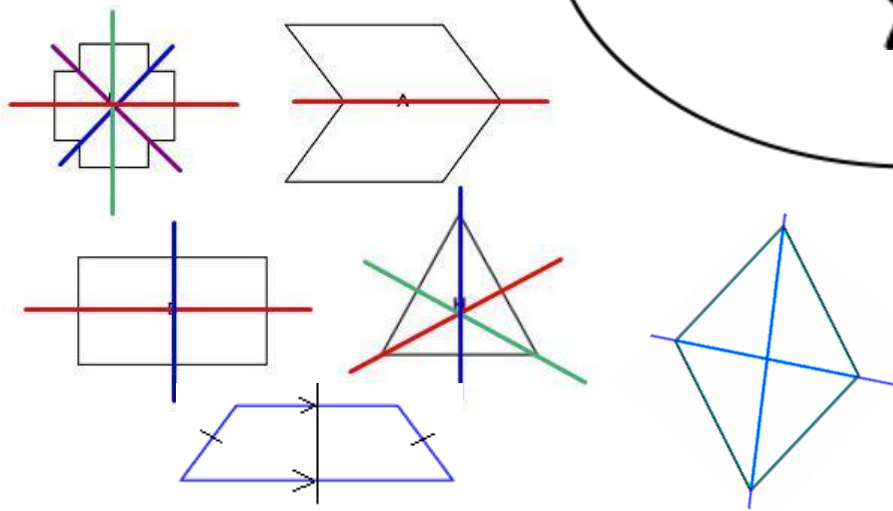
The symmetry that a figure has if it can be divided by a line into two parts that are mirror images.

CHARACTERISTICS

- The line of symmetry divides the shape into two equal pieces
- When the shape is folded along the line, the two pieces must overlap completely and perfectly
