## Become an Extension Master Gardener in County

If you have an interest in plants and gardening and would enjoy sharing that interest with others, apply to become a University of Minnesota Extension Master Gardener volunteer.

Applications are being accepted for the \_\_\_\_\_County Extension Master Gardener Program now until October 1, 2025.

Individuals joining the program begin an internship that starts with the Master Gardener core course training in January 2026. The course is taught online at the University of Minnesota Landscape Arboretum and is self-paced. Instructors are University of Minnesota Extension educators and faculty.

Following the course, interns will complete a minimum of 50 hours of volunteer service in the first year, working with local Master Gardener volunteers on a variety of projects that educate the public about gardening and horticulture. You might share your pollinator knowledge at a farmers market; help a Habitat for Humanity family plan their garden; or show children how to grow food at their schoolyard garden.
