
**1 Peter 2:21**, "For you were called to this, because Christ also suffered for you, <u>leaving you an example</u>, that you should follow in his steps."

**1 John 3:2-3,** "<sup>2</sup> Dear friends, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet been revealed. We know that when he appears, we will be like him because we will see him as he is. <sup>3</sup> And everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself just as he is pure. **Philippians 1:6** I am sure of this, that he who started a good work in you will carry it on to **completion** until the day of Christ Jesus.

Christlikeness: How are we made like Him?

Sanctification starts with God.

**Romans 8:29** "For those he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, so that he would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters."

**Philippians 2:13**, " For it is God who is <u>working in you</u> both to will and to work according to his good purpose."

**Hebrews 13:20-21,** " Now may the God of peace, who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus—the great Shepherd of the sheep—through the blood of the everlasting covenant, <sup>21</sup> Equip you with everything good to do his will, working in us what is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever.' Amen."

**1 Thessalonians 5:23-24**, "Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely. And may your whole spirit, soul, and body be kept sound and blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>24</sup>He who calls you is faithful; he will do it."

Because God is at work in us, we must engage in the battle for Sanctification.

**Philippians 2:12** <sup>12</sup> Therefore, my dear friends, just as you have always obeyed, so now, not only in my presence but even more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

**Romans 8:13,** "because if you live according to the flesh, you are going to die. But if by the Spirit you <u>put to death</u> the deeds of the body, you will live."

**2 Peter 1:5-8,** "5 For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with goodness, goodness with knowledge, 6 knowledge with self-control, self-control with endurance, endurance with godliness, 7 godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. 8 For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being useless or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ." **Galatians 5:16,** "16 I say, then, walk by the Spirit and you will certainly not carry out the desire of the flesh."

**Ephesians 6:11,** "Put on the full armor of God so that you can stand against the schemes of the devil."

James 4:7-10, "<sup>7</sup>Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup>Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. <sup>9</sup>Be miserable and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. <sup>10</sup> Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you."
