

**Subject: Urgent Request to Intervene at Ridglan Farms and End NIH-Funded Animal Testing**

Dear Secretary Kennedy,

I am writing to you today as a concerned citizen to urge you to use your authority as the Secretary of Health and Human Services to intervene in the ongoing crisis at Ridglan Farms in Wisconsin and to accelerate your commitment to ending animal experimentation across federal agencies.

As you are aware, Ridglan Farms is a massive breeding facility that supplies thousands of beagles annually for painful and often scientifically redundant experiments. Despite recent legal agreements that will see the facility surrender its state license by July 2026, hundreds of dogs remain trapped in horrific conditions—including documented instances of surgeries performed without anesthesia. These sentient beings continue to suffer in a system that values profit over compassion.

I respectfully ask that you:

- **Intervene for the Ridglan Beagles:** Use your federal oversight of the research supply chain to facilitate the immediate release of the remaining dogs at Ridglan Farms to legitimate sanctuaries and rescue organizations rather than allowing them to be sold into laboratories.
- **Redirect NIH Funding:** Immediately halt the allocation of NIH funds toward experiments that use live animals when advanced, human-relevant alternatives—such as the organoid technologies you have already championed—are available.
- **Support Legislation for Sentient Beings:** Use your platform to support federal laws that recognize the sentience of animals and provide them with meaningful legal protections against cruel and unnecessary research.

Your leadership on the "Make America Healthy Again" initiative has already signaled a historic shift toward more ethical science. By taking direct action for the Ridglan beagles, you can prove that this administration is truly committed to a "cruelty-free" scientific landscape that reflects our nation's evolving values.

Thank you for your time, your dedication to public health reform, and your consideration of this urgent humanitarian matter.
