

The LCC Library has updated its database login portal, so any links to database content (such as an article from EBSCO or a video from Films on Demand) will be different now. This only applies to direct URLs to databases or their content, NOT embedded content (such as Curriculum Builder reading lists).

Below are examples of the old vs. new Library database login pages. If your links are old, you will see the login screen on the left. If your links are up to date, you will see the new login screen on the right.

Old:




New:



How to get the new links to your content:

- 1. Click here to watch the video tutorial!
- 2. Go to your original content link and log in
- 3. When you are viewing the resource you want to provide a link to, find the button that says "Share," "Permalink," "Document URL," or something similar. Do NOT use the URL from your browser's address bar that is tied to your specific session and won't work again. You need to use the item URL provided by the database. Here's an example of where to find the URL to an article in EBSCO:



4. When you find the URL, copy it and paste it into Canvas (or wherever your link exists). Woohoo, you're done!

Pro Tip:

You can (and should) embed library content into your Canvas course! This eliminates the need for students to leave Canvas and log into the Library to access your resources. If you've already done this, you don't need to update anything. Yay, you! Here are the databases currently integrated with Canvas (click the links for tutorials on how to embed content for each):
