### Principal's Report - Pam

- 2019-2020 babies - still taking registration, encouraging registration sooner the better for staffing allocations for next year

## Chair's Report - Kristen/Stephanie

- Pizza Day - just finished winter round
  - Next round starts next week and goes to end of year - increase of 13 slices from last round
- Mahoodfest update
  - Things are going well



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- Busy booking items that school council approved to book
  - Dog show, cotton candy, balloon artist, popcorn etc
  - Robotics, firetrucks etc booked
- Raffle Permit
  - Traditionally Mahoodfest has had a raffle, baskets provided by each classroom based on a theme. As well as donations from families and businesses
  - The school board audit last year said we need an OGC license to host a raffle. This would include a lot of work, including opening a second bank account.
  - Cannot make it happen this year due to logistics of getting the accounts, license etc setup. Likely to be able to do it starting next year.
  - The new idea for this year is any large donated items will be up for silent auction, as no license is required
  - Any small donated items will be put into a “store”, where families can purchase items, proceeds will go towards Mahoodfest
- Volunteers
  - Last year we were short on volunteers, hoping to get more this year
  - Volunteers need to commit to only one hour

## Fundraising & Community Engagements

- Baden Coffee - made about \$900
  - About 30 families purchased, similar to poinsettias
  - Great fundraiser, would do it again
- April Bingo: April 25th, doors open at 6pm, Bingo starts at 7pm @ Lions hall
  - School Council is responsible for cleanup afterwards, put away tables and chairs
  - Will have a group table, let us know and a seat will be saved for you
  - Remember to bring loonies and toonies to buy additional cards
  - Starter package is \$25
  - Cash only
  - Bring your own bingo dabber or markers
- Pancake Day
  - Thankyou organizers and volunteers
  - Maple syrup festival committee donated all of the pancake mix and maple syrup
  - Costs were only measuring cups, pans and tinfoil
- Fundraising idea:
  - Compact Sod does fundraiser - big yellow bag
  - If setup, when you order you tell them you are with a school a portion of sales goes back to school
