 - Ability to become one of the top green communities in state which makes us eligible for certain grants
 - o School calendar for 2025-2026 is available
 - o Kindergarten Registration is this month
 - o Parker Middle School replacement project: moved forward to feasibility phase a few months early
 - Fall 2026 potential vote to approve new middle school design
 - Likely that this year's kindergarteners might be some of the first to go in
