

OTHER AIRFORCE INFO FOR MEDICAL PATHWAY

Officer:

- To become an Officer, you will need a bachelor's degree
- There are options for you to obtain these while enlisted
 - AF Academy
 - Must be under the age of 23 yrs
 - No children
 - No spouse
 - Must have Commander Approval
 - Nursing Program
 - Inter-service Physicians Assistance Program
 - Direct
 - Once you obtained your bachelor's degree, you can actually apply for Officer Training School (OTS).

FACTS:

- Diagnostic Imaging
 - College Courses in Algebra & Biology OR Algebra and General Science
 - College Course of English Composition I & Speech
- Physical Medicine
 - HS OR College Course in Human Anatomy, Physiology, Biology and Physical Sciences
 - College courses in Oral Communication, Written Communication and Mathematics
- Understand that because you have these courses completed, you are not guaranteed the jobs.
- My squadron policies:
 - Softbook (Junior in HS)
 - Begin the process 15 April 2025
 - Required to list a minimum of 5 jobs (you can only list 1 medical job)
 - You will be notified in October with the job you booked and a shipped date
 - Senior in HS
 - Begin the process as soon as senior year begins
 - Required to list a minimum of 8 jobs (you can only list 1 medical job)
- Prior to leaving for Basic Military Training (BMT) you will know your job
- You are required to live in a dormitory at your first duty station (Each base has their own requirements on moving out)
 - You will receive Base Housing Allowance & Sustainment Allowance once you move out of the dorms
- While Active-Duty, you can continue your education by using Tuitions Assistance (TA), which is \$4,500 a year. (Every year it replenishes)
 - You can pick any college to continue your education

- Online & in person (if you choose in person, make sure it works with your work schedule)
- **FUN FACT:** We have softball teams on base. They play intermural along with Air Force league (meaning you get to travel and play softball against others)
- While on Active-Duty status:
 - You will get a paycheck every 1/15 of the month
 - Your health care is provided
 - We have financial aids on base to help you budget
