

The Toast Problem

There will be three rounds to this activity. Each round will have different rules and time limits.

Round 1: On a piece of paper and using only drawings and symbols, illustrate in detail the steps to make toast. You will have 10 minutes to complete this round. Try to be as detailed as possible.

Socratic Question: How many steps does your drawing have?

Round 2: Write out the steps to make toast. You will have 5 minutes to complete this round.

Socratic Question: How many written steps do you have?

Round 3: In groups, share your ideas from round 1 and 2. What were common themes? How did the people in your group interpret the activity differently? Combine your ideas and create an infographic that demonstrates/instructs a person to make toast. You may use pictures of your drawings or use online images.

- I suggest first coming up with a list of steps that your group agrees on. Then you can decide what images you want to use. Next, arrange and rearrange your text and images until you are satisfied with the result.
- Keep the Elements of Art and Principles of Design in mind while you are working on your slide.
