

Women's Official Annual "GOOD STANDING" Checklist

- Pay local dues (Venmo \$35 to @UWLOA-Treasurer or cash at annual rules interpretation)
- [Register with UHSAA](#) if doing spring high school games.
- Hold current [USA Lacrosse Officials membership](#)
- Complete USA Lacrosse Girls Lacrosse Rules Course (only needs to be completed once)
 - o [usalacrosse.com](#) > log into your account > My Transcript > Girls Officials Annual Certification (current year) > Girls Officials - Rules & Penalties Course
- Pass the USA Lacrosse Rules Exam (must be completed to be assigned to games)
 - o [usalacrosse.com](#) > log into your account > My Transcript > Girls Officials Annual Certification (current year) > Girls Officials - NFHS Rules Exam & Youth Rules Exam
- Complete USA Lacrosse Professional Development
 - o [usalacrosse.com](#) > log into your account > My Transcript > Girls Officials Annual Certification (current year) > Girls Officials - Annual Professional Development
- Attend the annual UWLOA Training & Rules Interpretation (*usually the second Saturday of February*)
- Attend all required meetings
- Earn and maintain a USA Lacrosse Girls Official Certification (rating)
- Wear approved uniform
- Be consistent and impartial in making calls
- Be professional in both attitude and action toward other officials, coaches, and players – this includes notifying the assigner(s) of any conflicts of interest
- Update availability in Arbiter and accept games timely (try to enter your availability as far in advance as possible)**
- Read Rule Book and Manual** (manual located in the same place as the USAL rules exam)
