Some general issues

Dripping tap?

If you have a dripping tap and want to save water for the environment and the MQ water bill (we are metered as a development) then I have just changed two of my tap cartridges so thought it worth sharing the info on this.

Kitchen sink (20 teeth cartridge): I went to **Carem** (177 Trafalgar Rd. SE10 9TX) he has a box of about 10 different ceramic cartridges. You need his CC5 (£15+VAT for a pair). However the screw that holds the knob in place is too long – I think its 12mm and the CC5 may only take an 8mm screw. He supplied me with a shorter screw but a tapered head so it needed a couple of washers as well, but it seems to work OK. Take the cartridge and the knob and screw with you so as to avoid multiple trips to sort this out!

However, on the web I found a firm called **Tap Magician** (TM). I suspect their VRO3 at £8.99 a pair including delivery would be the right one, but you don't know until you try it, this comes with its own 10mm screw which presumable would fit. TM also do replacement ceramic disc kits at £1.99 – there is a risk that this won't fit the existing cartridge – but replacing the discs on the kitchen tap is easy and if I was doing it again I would probably first try this and then the VRO3 and finally Carem.

Bathroom sink (18 teeth cartridge): Carem supplies a Disco50 at £15 +VAT for a pair. This fits well – make sure you keep the existing screw for the knob etc. TM can't compete with this – its an Ideal Standard one (probably the tantadsic cartridge) and is very expensive, the

Disco50 is a copy of it.

If anyone is unsure what to do I am happy to assist or show them on mine.

Limescale removal

Have now fitted an AquaBion limescale removal device into the system and very pleased with the results so far, shower heads free flowing and not blocking, taps and plugs don't need so much attention and water flow improving. Manufacturer claims big energy cost reductions as well but too early to verify that..highly recommended piece of kit! Small and easy to fit with no ongoing running costs. The device cost £600 (incl vat) and plumber installation was £260 but I also had him do a couple of other jobs included in that. Not sure which model as my plumber recommended it and fitted it. It's fitted into the in pipe on the mains water supply (just after the stop cock) quite short and unobtrusive and yes it serves the whole flat.

We also recently fitted a quoker tap during the kitchen replacement which supplies cold filtered water which is perfect for drinking. [Sept 2018] ["Limescale remover" MQF Sept. 2018]
