

EDUCATION DEPARTMENT & UNDERSTANDING CURRICULUM ACT

ARTICLE I: THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Section 1. The Department of Education shall be created; it may also be known as the Education Department.

Section 2. The department shall be empowered with the ability to analyze research data from each stream; compile & store research information; publicize findings; suggest names of colleges/universities to the Senate; & make non-binding suggestions regarding research policies.

Section 3. The goal of the department is to report the status of research and to promote policies that will scientifically benefit the country.

Section 4. The department shall be officially classified as a government entity and thus subject to all rules on transparency, integrity, and other relevant regulations.

ARTICLE II: DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL

Section 1. The Education Department shall have at most three (3) individuals working within it at any given time.

- a. Those successfully appointed to the role may be known as Researchers.
- b. The Ministry shall have the power to appoint or remove Researchers.
- c. The only requirements for appointment are that Researchers are citizens of England, and that they do not serve within the Judicial branch.
- d. Researchers shall hold their position until dismissal by the Ministry or resignation.

ARTICLE III: INFRASTRUCTURE

Section 1. The Senate humbly requests that Moderation creates a channel for the Department of Education called; #education-department.

- a. This channel may be where Researchers post information that they've compiled.
- b. No members of the general public may comment in this channel.

Section 2. The Department of Education shall store all relevant files in a publicly accessible location.

Section 3. Members of the public may request specific information from the department and Researchers shall endeavour to fulfill the request at the best of their ability.
