

# 2026 WABL Trials Pre-registration Parent Briefing

It's essential that you read this briefing document in full if your child wishes to gain selection in a **2026 Perth Redbacks WABL team**

You <u>must</u> read this document, as things may have changed compared to previous years.

## What is WABL?

The WA Basketball League (WABL) is WA's representative junior competition. It is the next level up from Domestic basketball.

WABL is played for your basketball association. <u>You must be selected</u> to play in an association's WABL team.

There are 13 basketball associations that field teams in WABL:

- Cockburn Cougars
- East Perth Eagles
- Eastern Suns (Kalamunda)
- Hills Raiders (Mundaring)
- Joondalup Wolves
- Lakeside Lightning
- Mandurah Magic

- Perry Lakes Hawks
- Perth Redbacks
- Rockingham Flames
- South West Slammers (Bunbury)
- Warwick Senators
- Willetton Tigers

Each association can enter teams in each of the following age categories, boys and girls:

- U12 (players born in 2015/2016/2017)
- U14 (players born in 2013/2014)
- U16 (players born in 2011/2012)
- U18 (players born in 2009/2010)
- U20 (boys only players born in 2007/2008)
- U21 (girls only players born in 2006/2007/2008)

Typically, the maximum number of playing spots each association has available in each gender/age group (e.g., U14 Boys, U16 Girls) is **40**, and in some age groups, there are 100-150 players competing for those spots.

# The commitment involved with being a Perth Redbacks WABL Player

It's *really* important to understand the commitment involved with being a Perth Redbacks WABL player before you register your child and make them available for selection. It's very disruptive to a team and to our program to select a player and then find out they are unable to attend training sessions or make it to games.

Being part of the Perth Redbacks WABL program is a year-round commitment:

- starting with selection trials in October,
- *followed by* training for and competing in the State Champs tournament for your age group/team in October/November/December,
- then the WABL pre-season which includes the WABL grading tournament in February/March/April
- then the WABL season (16 rounds plus finals) which runs from April to September.

## 2025 State Champs Campaign

#### TRAINING COMMITMENT

**Two training sessions a week,** once teams have been announced (week of 27 October) through to your child's competition weekend (see competition dates below):

- One on Sunday (could be any time between 8am and 6pm at either the Leisurelife Centre, Vic Park or Belmont Oasis)
- One during the week (could be any afternoon/evening from Monday to Thursday at any number of venues - see 'Perth Redbacks Training Venues' for list)

#### **COMPETITION COMMITMENT**

**The competition weekend** for State Champs will see all teams play 4-5 games over the course of Saturday and Sunday (and sometimes, Friday evening). We will not know the game times for each team until 10 days before the competition weekend.

All selected players must attend ALL training sessions, even if injured, as well as the competition weekend.

## 2026 WABL Campaign

There may be some WABL training sessions held in January 2025. Players will be expected to attend these sessions unless away on a family holiday.

#### TRAINING COMMITMENT

During the WABL pre-season (February to April) and the WABL season (April to September), all teams will have two training sessions a week - one with their team and a skills session with their age group. The training sessions can take place on any evening from Monday to Friday. Training session allocations are done on coach availability, not player availability. It is expected that players prioritise their two WABL training sessions over other commitments. If a player has a commitment that precludes them from attending their team's allocated training sessions, they will not be able to take up their spot in our WABL program.

#### **COMPETITION COMMITMENT**

All WABL teams are required to attend the **WABL grading tournament** for their age group. The tournament dates are:

• Sunday 1 March 2026: Age groups TBC

• Sunday 9 March 2026: Age groups TBC

• Sunday 16 March 2026: Age groups TBC

• Sunday 23 March 2026: Age groups TBC

The **WABL** season starts on Sunday 26 April. It runs for 16 weeks + 3 weeks of finals. (There is a two-week break in the July school holidays.) **WABL** games are played on **Sundays** and can be any time from 7.30am to 6pm at venues all over Perth from Joondalup in the north to Bunbury in the south and Mundaring in the east.

#### Financial commitment

The fees involved in 2026 WABL are:

Trial fee: \$40

• State Champs fee: \$220

• WABL Pre-season Fee: \$250

• WABL Season Fee: \$650

Basketball WA Annual Fee (if not already paid via domestic): \$41.75

Basketball Australia Investment Levy Fee (if not already paid via domestic): \$5

• Weekly WABL Game Fee: \$15 per game

Redbacks WABL Compulsory Uniform items:

Black shorts: \$50Red shorts: \$55

# Perth Redbacks training venues

Perth Redbacks WABL teams train at a range of venues (not a single venue). We are unable to advise on where any teams will be training before trials, as these details are not finalised until the teams are announced.

The vital thing to know before registering your child for trials is that, if selected, your child's team training session could be on any night from Monday to Thursday, and could be at any of the following venues:

- Bob Hawke College
- Cannington Leisureplex
- Como Secondary College
- George Burnett Leisure Centre
- Perth HPC (formerly HBF Stadium, Mt Claremont)
- Loftus Recreation Centre
- Melville SHS
- Trinity College Foley Centre
- Trinity College Sports Centre

# Eligibility requirements for triallists

Players who represented Perth Redbacks in WABL 2025 (as either a player or train-on) must meet one of the following to be eligible to trial for a 2026 Perth Redbacks WABL team:

- Played in the Perth Redbacks 2025 Winter Domestic Competition
- Be registered to play in the Perth Redbacks 2025/26 Summer Domestic Competition
- Have sought and received an exemption from the above

There are no eligibility requirements for players who have never played WABL before or who played in a WABL team for another association in 2025. These players are welcome to register for Perth Redbacks 2026 WABL trials on the understanding that if they are selected for a 2026 Perth Redbacks WABL team, they must play in one of the following to be eligible for future (2027 onwards) Perth Redbacks WABL trials:

- Perth Redbacks 2026 Winter Domestic Competition
- Perth Redbacks 2026/27 Summer Domestic Competition

# Trial age groups

Please take careful note of the age group your child is in to ensure they attend the correct trial for the year they were born. We cannot offer exemptions to players who miss the correct trial for their age.

# Club expectations of players

All selected players are expected to:

- Abide by our players' code of conduct
- Attend all scheduled training sessions unless unwell. (Injured players are still expected to attend training.)
- Purchase the compulsory uniform items.
- Pay all registration fees by the payment deadlines.

# Club expectations of parents

All parents are expected to:

- Abide by our <u>parents</u> and <u>spectators</u>' codes of conduct and our <u>zero-tolerance</u> <u>behaviour policy</u>.
- Be available to be rostered on for scoring duties on their child's State Champs competition weekend and during the WABL season.

## Perth Redbacks 2026 WABL Selection Process

#### **OPEN TRIALS - OCTOBER 2025**

All players who meet the eligibility reuirements are invited to register and attend.

#### **TRIAL DATES**

#### TRIAL 0 - Saturday 18 October

For all boy players born 2009-2017 who did not play WABL in 2025.

#### TRIAL 1 - Sunday 19 October

All **girl** players born 2006-2017 (regardless of whether they played WABL in 2025 or not)
All **boy** players born 2007-2008 (regardless of whether they played WABL in 2025 or not)
All **boy** players born 2009-2017 who played WABL in 2025 (for any association, not just Redbacks)
All **boy** players invited to progress from Trial 0

#### TRIAL 2 - Sunday 26 October

For all players invited to progress from Trial 1

#### TRIAL 3 - Week of Monday 27 October

For all players invited to progress from Trial 2

#### **2025 WABL SQUAD SELECTED**

44 players\* in each age group
\*U18 Girls, U20 Boys, U21 Girls will have smaller squads,
U12 Boys will have a larger squad
