A-G Calculation Guide

Your A-G GPA determines your college eligibility and competitiveness. When you apply in the Fall of your senior year, your A-G GPA will be based on your ACADEMIC classes for 10th and 11th grade. 12th grade A-G GPA will be included in the transcript you send your college after 7th semester and/or at the end of your senior year.

Other Notes:

You should hand-calculate your A-G GPA. The box in your transcript for 10-12 academic GPA is NOT always accurate!

Extra GPA Points (for up to 5 courses):

- Dual Enrollment and Concurrent Enrollment (if the class is college-transferable).
- AP courses
- Any other classes with a small "+" sign in the margin

If you have 2 classes with the same subject in the same semester ONLY count one grade.

If a class has a "p" next to it, it should be calculated. This includes any credit recovery classes you took - if there is a "p," add it!

If a class has an "r" next to it, do NOT add it!

Classes with "P," "CR" and "NC" do not count at all, even if they have a "p". Do not add them.

Now, use your transcript to hand-calculate your current A-G GPA!

10th grade:

5 points A's in Community College Classes, AP Courses, and any other courses with a "+"	4 points A's in regular "p" classes B's in "+" classes	3 points B's in regular "p" classes C's in "+" classes	2 points C's in regular "p" classes	1 point D's in regular "p" classes AND "+" classes	O points F's in regular "p" classes AND "+" classes

11th grade:

5 points A's in Community College Classes, AP Courses, and any other courses with a "+"	4 points A's in regular "p" classes B's in "+" classes	3 points B's in regular "p" classes C's in "+" classes	2 points C's in regular "p" classes	1 point D's in regular "p" classes AND "+" classes	O points F's in regular "p" classes AND "+" classes

12th grade:

5 points A's in Community College Classes, AP Courses, and any other courses with a "+"	4 points A's in regular "p" classes B's in "+" classes	3 points B's in regular "p" classes C's in "+" classes	2 points C's in regular "p" classes	1 point D's in regular "p" classes AND "+" classes	O points F's in regular "p" classes AND "+" classes

A-G GPA: Total # of points / Total # of classes
