



Marianist Visitation State Community Seed Grants

The Visitation Marianist State Community began in 2012 an annual distribution of dollars granted to provide “Seeds for Tomorrow’s Church”. Grants are awarded in December each year to groups or ministries following an application process.

Proposals are accepted for programs or projects in four categories:

- Strengthen Marianist Lay Communities and Networks
- Assist in building the Church
- Impact the faith and involvement of young adults in the Church
- Social Justice including Economic Justice, Environmental Justice, and Human Rights

Approved grants are for an amount between \$1,000 and \$5,000.

Application Requirements

- Grant proposals must be sponsored by a member of the Marianist Family for a ministry in which he/she/they are directly involved or which he/she/they support.
- No person or organization may submit more than one grant proposal for each funding cycle.
- To be considered, a grant proposal must include a completed application and a detailed budget for the project and must be received on or before the due date, August 31, 2024, by 7 pm ET.
- Grant recipients are to submit a Summary Report describing the project outcome by August 15, 2025.

Those selected for grants will be notified by October 31, 2024. Grant funds will be distributed in December 2024.
