## **Activities:**

## Language Arts/Communication and Information Skills

- Create a journal entry about a time you found something and did not know what it was.
- Write about something that you think is a "wonder".
- Create a poster to advertise the showcase Spider creates for viewing the "wonder".

## Math/Science/Technology

- Research "things" that have fallen out of the sky or were seen in the sky throughout history.
- Research the various insects in the story.

#### Social Studies/History/Geography

- Plot on a map where "unknown objects" have fallen to earth from the sky.
- Discuss why people have been frightened throughout history when unknown things fell from, or were seen, in the sky.

## Art/Music/Drama
