FAQs

Q: Do I have to bring clothing to exchange in order to participate?

A: No, you do not need to bring clothing to participate. We always have more than enough clothing to go around.

Q: What type of clothing are you looking for?

A: Gently used, good condition, clean clothing in all sizes. No large stains or ripped/damaged clothing. We are especially looking for cold weather clothing like jackets and sweaters.

Q: Can I bring shoes to exchange?

Y: Yes, shoes are okay as long as they are in good condition with the soles still intact with some tread and in pairs (no lonely singles please).

Q: Can I drop off clothing donations ahead of time?

A: Yes you may drop of clothing in the Women's Resource Center- Smith Memorial Student Union, 1825 SW Broadway #439 on Wednesday or Thursday (Nov 20th and 21st) between 9am-5pm

Q: Do I have to wash my clothes before bringing them?

A: Yes. Unlike last year, we will not be able to wash clothing first. They don't need to be freshly washed but should be clean and free of strong detergent or perfume odors as some folks are sensitive to artificial fragrances.

Q: What happens with clothing that is leftover?

A: We will be donating them to local nonprofits if possible. Some may be stored for future swaps as room allows.

Q: Is this event only open to queer and trans students?

A: No. While this event centers our queer and trans students in gaining access to free gender-affirming clothing, student allies and non-student community members are welcome.
