

Grading details for all withdrawals

Course Withdrawals/Drops

- **During the first five days of the term (Drop/Add)** – Course(s) dropped by students in Self-Service receive **no grade** and are removed from the transcript.
- **After Drop/Add and by the last day to withdraw** – Course withdrawals generated by students in Self-Service result in **W grades** and use withdrawal credits. A limit of 16 withdrawal credit hours is available during your career at Appalachian State. Course withdrawals will be included in attempted hours and counted in Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) for Financial Aid recipients.

Full Term Withdrawals For Current Term

- **Beginning on the first day of classes of the term and by the last day to withdraw** – Full term withdrawals of all courses *must* be submitted on the [Withdraw From Current/Future Term form](#) and will result in **W grades** with no withdrawal credits used. These course withdrawals will be included in attempted hours and counted in SAP for Financial Aid recipients.

Approved Late Full Term Withdrawals For Current Term

- **After the last day to withdraw** – Courses receive **W grades** with no withdrawal credits used. These course withdrawals will be included in attempted hours and counted in SAP for Financial Aid recipients.

Approved Retroactive Full Term Withdrawals

- **After any academic term is completed** – Courses receive **W grades** with no withdrawal credits used. These course withdrawals will be included in attempted hours and counted in SAP for Financial Aid recipients.
