## Raindrop IO


You might want to think about getting it. I use it because I can add information to bookmarks, categorize them, add tags, etc. It's most helpful for learning

My dirty little secret is also that I had more than 50,000 bookmarks and they became unmanable. I selectively brought the most useful to Raindrop and can now manage them.

That's kind of the main problem with Chrome Bookmarks. You can't really organize them, search by specific folder, etc. The search limitation was among the most annoying. Any search looks in all folders so you can't limit it to the most recent folders you're using.
