Visitors to Galva Elementary:

Please remember that all exterior doors are locked throughout our school day. Visitors are limited to scheduled meetings, deliveries, repairs, or specified pick-ups.

- 1. All visitors must check-in at the middle doors of the building labeled "Galva Elementary School."
- 2. Please buzz in at the door, look at the camera, and state your name and reason for entering.
- 3. All visitors must check-in and sign-in at the Elementary Office. Visitors will be issued a "Visitor" lanyard.
- 4. Parents/guardians needing to pick up a student for an appointment are asked to contact the office in advance so their student(s) can be called to the office and signed out.

School Arrival Times/Location:

The first day of school for K-6 Students is Friday, August 16, 2024, from 8:00 AM - 1:55 PM. Lunch will be served that day. We expect students to arrive in the building between 7:45 and 7:55 AM and enter through the Gymnasium doors. *Doors will not open until 7:45*. Breakfast will be available for students, if desired, starting at 7:30 AM. Breakfast students would enter through the playground and into the Cafeteria doors.

K-6 Regular Schedule - 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM

The first day of school for PreK Students is Monday, August 19, 2024.

Pick-Up/Drop-Off:

Car drop-off will take place on Morgan Road in front of the school. Cars are expected to drop off with vehicles moving towards the WEST. Students can enter through the Gym Doors. If a student is wanting breakfast, they can enter the playground and proceed through cafeteria doors. There is NO PARKING on Morgan Rd. in the morning prior to school.

Buses will line up first and pick students up. Cars cannot move until buses have left the front of the school. Cars will enter the line on Morgan Rd. and proceed moving toward the WEST. There is NO PARKING on Morgan Rd. immediately after school during pick-up.
