Lesson 11: Hamzatul Wasl

Hamzatul wasl (هُمْزَةُ الْوَصُل) is also called "the connecting hamza." Hamzatul wasl is only found at the beginning of words. It's created by drawing the head of ص on the letter alif, like this:

٦

Since *hamzatul wasl* only comes at the beginning of words, it is the glue between two words. In this case, if you read without stopping, you skip the *hamzatul wasl*. Here's an example:

Phrase	Skip Wasl	Pronunciation
وَ ٱلْقَلَمِ	وَ لْقُلْمِ	وَ لْقَلَمِ

Another rule is **any letter before or after** *hamzatul wasl* that has no marking is also skipped. (Exception: the letter $\dot{\upsilon}$)
