

## **2024 FW Club eBoard Elections**

Elections for new officers of the MSU Fisheries and Wildlife Club eBoard for 2024 will be held on Thursday, November 16th, at 6:30 pm in room 152 of Natural Resources! Each position will start January 2024 and end December 2024. You must be an MSU undergraduate student for the entirety of this time frame to be eligible to run.

EBoard members are expected to attend every general meeting as well as bi-weekly eBoard meetings. You can run for any position regardless of past experience - most of the current eBoard members will be around in the spring semester to help oncoming officers with their new positions as needed.

If you are interested in running for a position, sign your name below. **You can run for more than one position if you are not elected for your first pick.** Be prepared to give a short speech (1-5 min) in front of the club explaining why you are interested in the position and why you think you would be a good fit. - *Frequently communicate via email with professors, biologists/professionals, and students.*
- *This position also plays a major role in facilitating student attendance to conferences (applying for grants, budgeting, travel organization), both regional and national; although other positions play a large role in this too (treasurer, vice president).*
- *Presidents should be very organized, be able to multi-task and delegate, and be professional and punctual as a leader of the organization. Most importantly, the president should be passionate about the FW Club and should bring enthusiasm to every meeting!*
