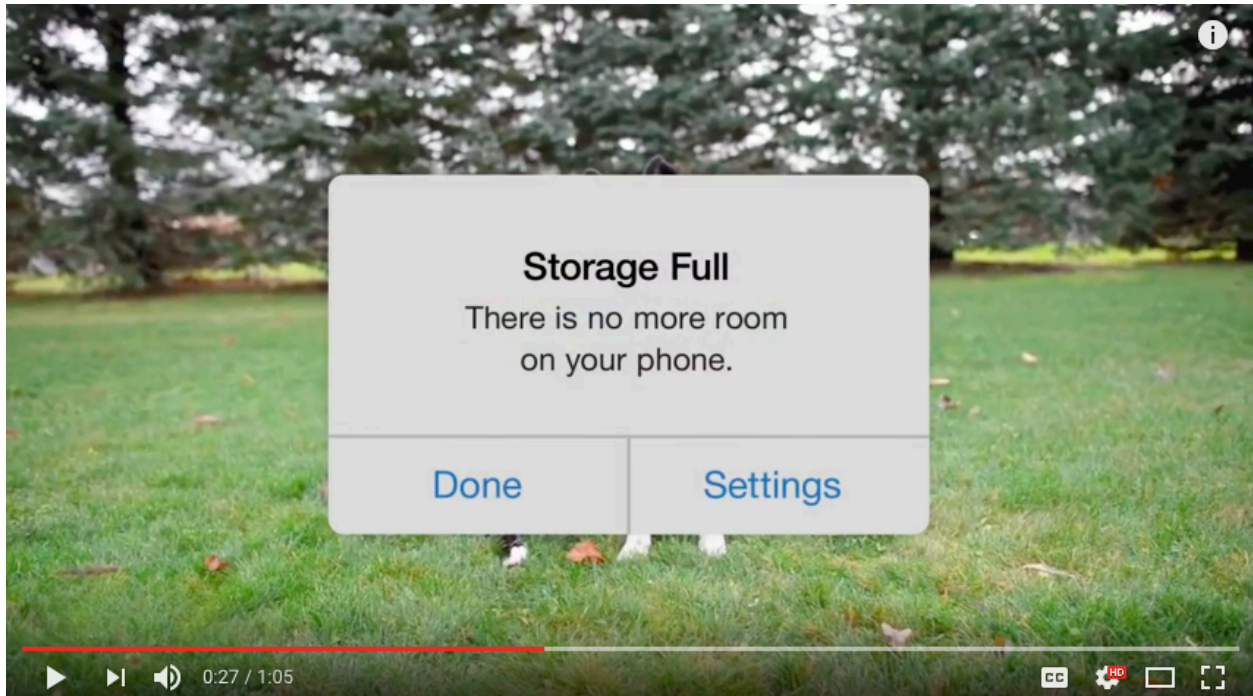

Store Your Photos

- Unlimited free storage (each photo can be up to 16 MP) - for most people this is plenty of resolution
- Can also save original size photos if larger than 16 MP under Google Storage Plan
- Automatic upload to Google Photos from mobile devices using a variety of settings - for example only upload when on wifi or when charging

- Can upload photos from your computer
- Can download a batch of photos in zip file format to store locally or then upload to another source for backup

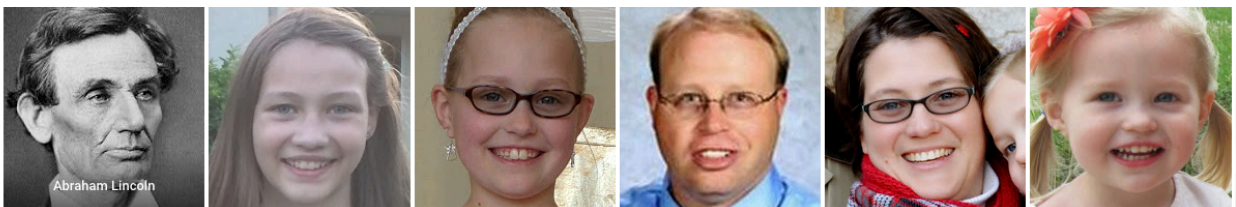

← People

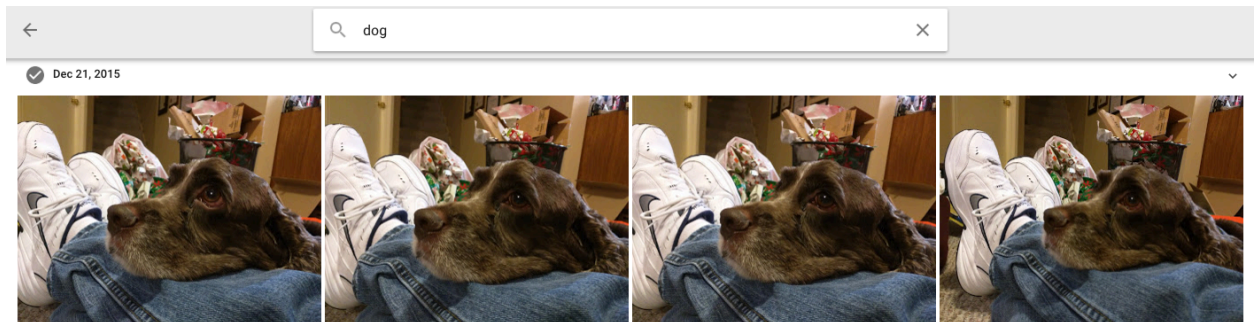


- Search by location if geotagged

- Organize into albums - limit of 500 photos added at a time
- Limit of 2000 total photos in an album
- Share albums

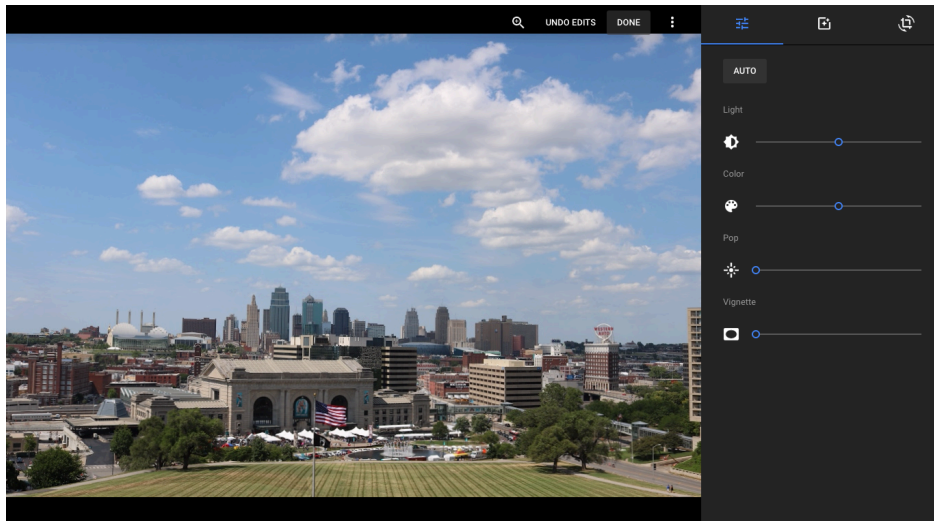
