## Camp Edwards Frequently Asked Questions

Camp Edwards Address: N8901 Army Lake Rd, East Troy, WI 53120

**What should my student pack?** We will provide a packing list. Your child will be spending a lot of time outdoors. Please pack clothes and shoes that you do not mind getting dirty. Everyone will need a pillow and sleeping bag or blanket. No linens are provided at camp. They will also need a towel. Students are expected to follow the dress code policies (no ripped jeans, midriff shirts, etc.) that we have in place for out of uniform days.

**How do I sign up to chaperone?** See link to the sign up genius to volunteer and/or send snacks.

**When does my student return to school?** Students come back Friday around 1:30pm, and we highly recommend picking them up then because they will be exhausted!

**How do I send any medications my student needs?** All medications need to be labeled and with dosages in a ziplock bag with the student's name on it. If it is a prescription medication, we need a doctor's note, so please plan ahead!

**Can my student bring their phone or a device to listen to music?** Absolutely NO electronic devices. If students bring it, it will be taken and kept until the end of the trip.

**What will my student be eating? What if they have allergies?** If there are any dietary restrictions, let us know as SOON as possible. Camp Edwards needs to prepare their kitchen for when we come. They offer an alternative meal to those with allergies or dietary restrictions.

**Is there someone designated to hold onto the medications?** Yes, Ms. Dahl will hold on to them and make sure they get their meds.

**How will my student get to Camp Edwards?** The students are taking a bus there and back. Chaperones are asked to drive their own car.

**What is the cabin/room situation?** There are rooms of 3 or 4 students. The boys are on the ground floor, chaperones (women included) can stay on the upper floor of that cabin. There needs to be at least 1, but hopefully 2, male chaperones to stay on the floor with the boys. For the girls cabin, students stay on the upper level.

**Can my student bring a snack?** We will keep any snacks in the shared kitchen in the cabin, we ask that they do not take any food into the rooms. We have a limited time to clean on Friday morning.

**Do I have to chaperone the entire three days?** Parents can chaperone just for one night, for a day, or for a few hours. Most parents come in and out and don't stay the whole time. The two teachers will be there the whole time.

**Do I need to do anything to be a chaperone?** Chaperones need to be Safeguarded before the trip. If you are not by the time of the trip you will not be able to come. There is no fee for chaperones, meals are included.

**How much does Camp Edwards cost? What if I can't afford the trip right now?** If there are any financial hardships, please let Mrs. Runnoe know at [mrunnoe@saintsebs.org](mailto:mrunnoe@saintsebs.org) or call the office and ask to speak with her. St. Sebastian will help out, we don't want any student to miss this experience due to financial constraints. The total for this field trip is \$165.

**If I am chaperoning overnight, what should I bring?**

See student packing list for ideas and essentials - would recommend a fitted twin sheet, blanket/sleeping bag, pillow, towel, change of clothes, layers, shower items, etc.
