Medical History:

O5-4 has a multitude of scars adorning his face, back and forearms. These were gained during various global conflicts throughout his career. His right eye has been damaged to the point of no repair. Zero vision can be displayed from that side. O5-4 is required to have frequent medical checkups with the Site he is visiting at the time to ensure old injuries do not fester into any issues going forward. Psychological evaluations are to be done bi-weekly as per order from The Ethics Committee after several run ins with questionable testing. Recent evaluations suggest a desire to outmatch the Foundation's enemies with superior technology, at any cost.

Any variation of mental stability is to be reported to the Site-65 Ethics branch immediately to ensure O5-4 is kept in good mental wellbeing. Such incident has occurred and been logged under medical incident #3152A.
