



EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 13998

Of the 28th of December, 2021

WHEREAS the procedure of termination of pregnancies, referred to as “abortions”, results in at least one death of an individual every time it is carried out; and,

WHEREAS this casualty rate is obscenely high and ways to reduce this must be found before abortions are carried out further; and,

WHEREAS the Occupational Safety and Health Administration has a responsibility to guarantee safe and casualty-free medical procedures; and,

WHEREAS under the terms of Executive Order 13994, the life of an unborn child after detection of heartbeat is indeed considered a complete human life for all regulatory intents and purposes; and,

WHEREAS this life is lost with each abortion procedure, thus making every abortion unsafe:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Adith Manikandan Uttara Suryaganesh, President of the United States, under and by the virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution, statutes, and treaties of the United States of America, and as Commander-In-Chief of the armed forces, do hereby order as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

- (1) The purpose of this Executive Order is to improve safety of terminations of pregnancies by ensuring that the casualty rates of terminations of pregnancies are reduced.
- (2) Currently, every abortion leads to at least one death. This is a casualty rate of 100%, and such a procedure cannot be allowed to continue without further scientific research into reducing this number.
- (3) The Occupational Safety and Health Administration has the legal mandate to place regulations on procedures to prevent workplace fatalities as per the Occupational Safety

and Health Act. Therefore, the purpose of this Executive Order is to direct the Occupational Safety and Health Administration to prepare a new rule for entry to the Federal Register that will utilize this authority to prevent abortions from taking place without some means of reducing workplace fatalities.

SECTION 2: INSTRUCTIONS TO THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

- (1) The Secretary of Health and Human Services, to whom the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Occupational Safety and Health reports, is hereby directed to order the Assistant Secretary to prepare a Rule with content as follows:

RULE #XXXX

- (a) No medical procedures involving terminations of pregnancies may be carried out unless the procedure can guarantee beyond reasonable doubt the safety of the life of the unborn child before and after the procedure.*
 - (b) For the purposes of this Rule, the definition of “life” shall be consistent with the recognition of the Right to Life as outlined in [E.O. 13994](#).*
 - (c) Violations of this Rule shall be investigated and violators subjected to penalties under the OSHA Act and other provisions of the law.*
- (2) The rule shall be issued immediately and shall be held applicable to all medical procedures.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATES

- (1) This Executive Order shall come into effect immediately upon its publication in the Federal Register.
