Archery: A great way to learn how to shoot a bow. You will go over safety and technique, learn the basic form, and try for the bull's-eye!

Tennis: Our well-maintained 8 hard surface courts are positioned in the very heart of camp. Whether you are picking up a racket for the first time or have already taken lessons, Greystone Tennis is for you!
