

Pre-Visit Guide: Landscape of Stories – Hotel Fatigue

About the experience

Hotel Fatigue is an immersive site-specific theatre performance that the Continuo Theater is preparing in the premises of the former Blanice hostel in Týn nad Vltavou

The performance takes place across several floors of the building, and audience members move between different spaces at their own pace. You can travel between floors either by stairs or by lift.

Please wear clothing that will allow you to feel comfortable throughout the experience.

Duration: 150 minutes

Recommended age: 12+

Key accessibility information

Venue: Blanice Hostel, Týn nad Vltavou

Performance space: Indoor of a multi-storey building.

Getting around the venue: There is one step at the entrance. A portable access ramp will be available. The upper floors can be reached by lift (entrance width: 90 cm; control panel height: 90 cm). Lift access between floors.

Door width: Minimum 80 cm.

Thresholds: Maximum 3 cm (only to rooms that visitors do not need to enter).

Language: The performance includes occasional use of various world languages. Essential instructions are interpreted into Czech.

Sensory environment: Flashing and changing lights, loud sounds and artificial smoke.

Content: Nudity, violence, and emotionally intense scenes.

Getting there

By public transport

The nearest local bus stop is **Hlinecké sídliště**. See its location here ([mapy.cz](#), [Google Maps](#)).

Low-floor accessible buses operate only at selected times. Wheelchair-accessible buses operate only at selected times.

The Týn nad Vltavou bus / coach station is approximately a 20-minute walk from the venue. See its location here ([mapy.cz](#), [Google Maps](#)).

Some regional bus services also stop at:

- **Jiráskova Street** (approximately 10 minutes on foot)
- **Hlinecké sídliště** (directly in front of the Blanice complex)

By South Specific shuttle bus

A South Specific shuttle bus is available on **31 July** and **7 August 2026**.

The shuttle is intended exclusively for visitors attending Hotel Fatigue and departs at **6:00 pm** from the South Bohemian Theatre. See the departure location here ([mapy.cz](#), [Google Maps](#)).

By car

The venue can be reached directly by car.

Free parking is available directly in front of the Blanice Hostel complex.

Additional parking is available in the nearby Hlinky housing estate.

There are no designated accessible parking spaces.

There are no electric vehicle charging stations directly at the venue. The nearest charging station is approximately a 20-minute walk away at Tábořská 833. See its location here ([mapy.cz](#), [Google Maps](#)).

The Venue

The performance takes place inside the former **Blanice Hostel**, located near the **Hlinecké sídliště** in Týn nad Vltavou.

The building will be clearly marked with the **Hotel Fatigue** sign.

The building can be reached via asphalt footpaths.

What to expect on arrival

The building opens to the audience at **18:30 / 6:30 p.m.**

From the moment you enter the building, you become a hotel guest.

Tickets are checked at the reception desk, located on the ground floor. The reception is located on the ground floor. The reception counter is 90 cm high.

If capacity allows, tickets can also be purchased at reception. Reserved tickets must be collected there.

There is no cloakroom in the building.

If needed, larger luggage can be left at reception.

If necessary, electronic devices or assistive equipment can be charged at reception.

There is also a bar on the ground floor where alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks are available. The bar counter is 95 cm high.

During the performance

The performance takes place across three floors of the building. Audience members move between different parts of the building throughout the experience, using either the stairs or the lift.

The performance takes place inside an old building that is normally closed to the public. Some rooms may be dusty, dark, and relatively confined.

Audience members spend approximately one third of the performance standing, one third walking, and one third sitting. They are free to move around the designated areas at their own pace. Please follow the instructions of the hotel staff. You are welcome to communicate with them, but should not interfere with the ongoing performance.

If necessary, audience members may leave the performance and re-enter. Please inform a member of the hotel staff, who will assist you.

Animals are not permitted inside the building, with the exception of assistance dogs.

Smoking and photography or video recording are prohibited.

Sensory information

During the performance, you may encounter:

- flashing lights,
- changing lighting conditions,
- increased noise levels,
- artificial smoke and theatrical effects.

Safety and evacuation

An accessible evacuation procedure is in place.

Emergency exits are clearly marked. In the event of an emergency, trained staff will guide you to the nearest exit.

Fire extinguishers are available on site.

A first aid kit will be located at reception.

Content information

The performance is recommended for audiences aged **12 and over**. Parents and guardians are responsible for accompanying children.

The performance includes:

- nudity,
- violence,
- Weapons and guns,
- emotionally intense scenes.

Language and accessibility

Various world languages are occasionally used during the performance. Understanding these languages is not necessary to follow the performance. Essential instructions will be interpreted into Czech.

Toilets

Separate toilets are located inside the building, on the ground floor.

A portable accessible toilet is located to the right of the entrance doors when exiting the building (or to the left of the entrance when approaching the building). It is reached via a level paved pathway.

The portable accessible toilet may be used at any time during the performance. If you need to leave the building or re-enter during the performance, please speak to a member of staff. Staff members will be present on every floor and will be happy to assist you.

Alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks as well as light refreshments are available:

- Before the performance at the ground-floor bar (18:30–19:00).
- After the performance at the upstairs bar / hotel restaurant.

Payment by card and cash is accepted.
