As a Confirmation/RCIA sponsor, your role is to encourage the faith of your candidate and be an "example" to your candidate and to reflect with the candidate on the meaning of a life of Catholic discipleship.

To perform the role of sponsor, it is necessary that a person fulfill the conditions stated in the Code of Canon Law #874:

1. be designated by the one to be baptized (confirmed), or by the parents or the one who takes their place or, in their absence, by the pastor or minister and is to have the qualifications and intention of performing this role
2. have completed the sixteenth year, unless a different age has been established by the diocesan bishop or it seems to the pastor or minister that an exception is to be made for a just cause
3. be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the sacrament of the Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken [e.g. if married, marriage must be recognized by the Catholic Church as valid]
4. not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared
5. not be the father or the mother of the one to be baptized (confirmed)

2. Haya cumplido dieciséis años, a no ser que el Obispo diocesano establezca otra edad, o que, por justa causa, el párroco o el ministro consideren admisible una excepción;
3. Sea católico, este confirmado, haya recibido ya el santísimo sacramento de la Eucaristía y lleve, al mismo tiempo, una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir;
4. No esté afectado por una pena canónica legítimamente impuesta o declarada; (*ejemplo: si es casado, debe ser un matrimonio reconocido por la Iglesia Católica como válido.*)
5. No sea el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar (confirmar).
