Hello! This supply list is for people who are not sure they like watercolor painting yet. Maybe you just want to get your feet wet (haha). This contains the **BARE MINIMUM** of what you need. You will need to mix colors (purple, orange, green). I really strongly recommend people shopping off of my other supply list that has **all** the things you need. However, if you just want to try one class and not buy everything all at once, you can use this list instead. It still contains professional watercolor supplies, but you won't see as many colors or brush sizes. (**Make sure you scroll down to page 2 to see all supplies.**)

If anything is out of stock on <u>Blick Art Materials</u> website, another good place to order from is <u>Jerry's Artarama</u>. They just don't have the Utrecht brushes at Jerry's for some reason.

Paint:

You do **NOT** need to buy white or black. We don't use white paint and we mix our own black paint.
