

Refunds

Cancellations requested prior to May 1 are eligible for a 50% refund. Starting May 1, all registrations are considered final and non-refundable.

Cancellations

To ensure the best experience for our students and instructors, each camp must meet a minimum number of participants. If a camp is canceled, all registered families will receive a full refund. Please be aware that registrations occurring within two weeks of the start date are subject to instructors approval.

Behavior Policy

Behavior expectations can be found in the HCA parent/student handbook (available upon request), and apply to all camps and experiences held on HCA's campus. Any student found to not be in compliance may be asked to leave the camp, and in this case no refund would be given.

HERITAGE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY SUMMER SPORTS CAMP PERMISSION, WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT

1. Voluntary, Recreational Participation. I acknowledge that my child's participation in Heritage Christian Academy ("HCA") summer camps is voluntary.
2. Permission to Participate. I grant permission for my child ("Child"), to participate in HCA summer camps and related activities (collectively, the "Camp Activities").
3. Acknowledgment and Assumption of Risk. I understand and acknowledge that summer camps involve inherent and unavoidable risks, including risks that may result in serious bodily injury, permanent disability, or death, even when reasonable care is exercised. Without limiting the foregoing, I acknowledge and understand that risks associated with the Camp Activities include, but are not limited to:

- a. Physical movement and activity associated with academic, enrichment, recreational, artistic, or extracurricular programming, including walking, standing, sitting, group activities, games, rehearsals, classroom participation, or transitions between activities, which may result in slips, trips, falls, or collisions with objects or other participants;
- b. Minor physical injuries such as strains, sprains, bruises, scrapes, or fatigue arising from participation in Camp Activities or extended periods of activity or concentration;
- c. Use of equipment, supplies, furniture, props, technology, classroom materials, or recreational items that may be misused, improperly handled, or malfunction;
- d. Conditions of indoor and outdoor facilities, including classrooms, gymnasiums, playgrounds, fields, theaters, cafeterias, hallways, stairways, and common areas, which may be uneven, crowded, wet, or otherwise present tripping or slipping hazards;
- e. Environmental conditions, including heat, cold, humidity, sun exposure, air quality, or exposure to allergens or irritants in indoor or outdoor spaces;
- f. Fatigue, dehydration, or minor illness associated with participation in daily programming or outdoor activities;
- g. Emotional or social discomfort that may arise from group participation, academic challenges, performance or presentation activities, feedback from instructors, or interactions with other participants;
- h. Transportation-related risks associated with travel to, from, or during Camp Activities, including walking trips, bus transportation, or field trips, if applicable;
- i. Acts or omissions of other participants, students, staff members, volunteers, or third parties; and

j. Aggravation of pre-existing physical, medical, emotional, or psychological conditions, whether known or unknown.

I understand that these risks cannot be eliminated, and that injuries may occur regardless of supervision, training, instruction, or safety precautions. I knowingly and voluntarily assume all such risks on behalf of my Child, including risks that are known or unknown, foreseeable or unforeseeable to the extent permitted under Minnesota law.

4. Waiver and Release of Liability. In consideration of my Child being permitted to participate in the Camp Activities, I, individually and as parent or legal guardian of my Child, for myself, my Child, and our respective heirs, personal representatives, and assigns, hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue Heritage Christian Academy and its directors, officers, employees, coaches, instructors, volunteers, and agents (collectively, "HCA") from any and all claims arising from ordinary negligence, excluding any claims arising from gross negligence, willful misconduct, or intentional acts, for injury, illness (including death), or property loss arising out of or related to my Child's participation in the Camp Activities, whether occurring on or off HCA premises.
5. Medical Authorization. I certify that my Child is physically and medically able to participate in the Camp Activities. I authorize HCA to obtain emergency medical treatment for my Child if deemed necessary. I understand that HCA may not have medical personnel on site at all times and that I am responsible for all medical expenses incurred.
6. Indemnification. To the fullest extent permitted by Minnesota law, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless HCA from claims or damages arising out of my Child's acts or omissions in connection with the Camp Activities.
7. Binding Effect; Post-Majority Claims. This Waiver and Release is executed by the undersigned parent or legal guardian on behalf of the Child and shall be binding

upon the Child, the parent(s) or guardian(s), and their respective heirs and assigns, including after the Child reaches the age of majority.

8. Severability and Governing Law. If any portion of this agreement is held invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect. This Permission, Waiver, Release of Liability, and Assumption of Risk Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota.
9. Acknowledgment. I have read this Permission, Waiver, Release of Liability, and Assumption of Risk Agreement, fully understand its terms, and understand that I am giving up substantial legal rights on behalf of myself and my Child. I sign this agreement freely and voluntarily.
