 - b. Overwhelming support to use the bonds to support intervention --- trying to see if we can fund Imagine Learning through HSC funds and other channels

- c. We have \$51K to fund programs and overall – we are serving 80 ELLs – we have 65 students at a time at 6 week rotation and using Literably / District assessment to support these students of need. Students who are identified to use the LLI programs – are about 2 years behind in learning growth so exiting the program shows improvement which can take about 1 year to see strengths. These are students not identified with IEPs, SDC, this is the “middle” of the group students who are lacking learning strengths. 7 students will be exiting the program showing growth.
