

# FAQ'S

1. If I'm on the waitlist, can I just come?
  - a. Unfortunately, not for the events at a public venue, the managers want a strict head count due to the fire code and staff. On MEETUP, the app will AUTOMATICALLY add you to GOING when someone cancels. I won't personally add or delete; there are no exceptions. Our apologies. Now, for private events, just text the number in the info section of the event before its start date. If you would like additional guests to come, please be courteous so preparations can be made for the number of people coming (food, drinks, etc).
2. Do I need to RSVP on Meetup and get a ticket on Eventbrite?
  - a. No, it's only necessary to get a ticket/RSVP on one platform, and it WILL be honored.
3. How many guests can I bring?
  - a. It's specific to each event. Please read the directions and info on each event carefully, as they will be described per event.
4. How long will everyone be at the event?
  - a. That's again on a case by case basis and will be posted on where the event details can be found, the host will essentially leave at the time set on the event.
5. Is the age range enforced heavily?
  - a. No its not
6. What if I don't agree to the media consent release?
  - a. For most events now, in today's time, integrating social media is integral for allbusinessess, but we do want all to experience. Please know that RSVP/purchase of any ticket is an automatic agreement to media release. For the PERSONAL NON-marketed events, please see the host for that event to express your concerns.
7. Who and where is my host?
