Mission Statement: Our mission is to ensure our students future success through learning, growing, and reaching new heights.

### **Priority #1**

**Improvement Plan Focus Area:** Increase phonological awareness and reading automaticity for students in first and second grade by 3%.

**Priority Area:** Based on the identified focus area, what issue needs to be addressed to achieve the goal?

The continuation of training and support for teachers to implement the best teaching practices and curriculum to increase phonological awareness and reading automaticity in students in grades kindergarten and first grade by 3%. All certified teachers at Carlisle Elementary have attended either K-2 RISE or 3-6 RISE in order to ensure that teachers know the Science of Reading and are teaching students with appropriate SoR strategies in their classrooms. We use the state approved phonics curriculum, Phonics First, as our core phonics instruction. We will begin supplementing our instruction in the areas of phonemic awareness and phonics with UFLI. (The University of Florida Literacy Institute) This is a research based curriculum that has an easy to follow manual that addresses all of the areas essential in learning to read.

**Desired Outcome:** When fully implemented, what will be different as a result of addressing this priority?

**Root Cause(s):** What is the heart of the issue? What evidence supports this conclusion?

The heart of the issue is that too many students are "In Need of Support" on the reading assessment. The evidence that supports this claim is the scores on the NWEA reading assessment. Furthermore, those students were assessed with DIBELs, the Advanced Decoding Assessments, and the PAST assessment. These assessments also proved that foundational skill instruction and practice are needed.
