

My brother, the islamist

Task 1: (pair work)

Spend 50 minutes watching and discussing parts of the documentary "My Brother, the islamist".

Watch some of [part 2](#) VTS_01_2.VOB - 0 – 13:00)

Pause it and discuss the following

- What do the Islamists think of Western values?
- What do the Islamists think of Muslims who are not Islamists?
 - o Pay special attention to the debate in part 1: approx. 11:30
- What's going on in the encounter with the drunk man? (part 1, 16:10 – part 2, 0:28)
 - o You need to [record yourselves](#) having a conversation where you comment on the scene using the terminology that you have from the table that you made when you compared and contrasted Islamist values and Western values, [task 5](#).
 - o So show a short sequence from the encounter, pause it, and record yourselves talking about it. Then show the next short sequence, etc.

We'll discuss your pair work in class and watch some of your recordings.

Task 2: (group work)

Documentaries are considered Non-Fiction and therefore we should look for the intention and the reliability of the piece.
