

Website Home Page Guidelines

If you made a website, your home page (the first page on your website) should be your title page. You will not make a separate Google Doc title page.

Include the following, in this order:

Your Name

Title

Senior Division

Individual/Group Website

Student-Composed Word Count:

Multimedia:

Process Paper Word Count:

Notes on the requirements:

- Your Name - Replace this with your first and last name.
- Title - Replace this with your title.
- Senior Division - Leave this just as it is. The Senior Division is the High School division.
- Individual/Group Website - Write "Individual Website" if you are doing a project along. Write "Group Website" if you are working with a group.
- Student-Composed Word Count - Include the words "Student-Composed Words:" and then write the number of words *written by you* that you have on your project. This does not include quotations from your sources. See [this video to understand how to count words](#). See [this video to see the "word count" tool in Google Docs on the iPad](#). (*Websites allow a max of 1,200 words.*)
- Multimedia - Include the length of any video/audio that you have embedded in your website (if any). (*You are limited to 3 minutes of audio/video.*)
- Process Paper Word Count - Include the words "Process Paper Word Count:" and then write the number of words in your process paper.
