KS- other school have absolutely addressed this, but it's not a big issue here. SB- foul language? KS- yes that's addressed here. • School Improvement Plan: TDSB has mandated certain goals. CR staff have modified goals from last year. Main focus this year is improvements in math and language. Also trying to stress the importance of EQAO upon the students.
