## I.4 The Administrative and Academic Councils function Effectively.

The Administrative and Academic Councils of Partido State University function effectively as collegial bodies that guide institutional governance and decision-making in their respective domains. The Administrative Council serves as the advisory body to the University President on matters related to administration, finance, and support services, ensuring that policies and programs are aligned with institutional goals and national standards. Meanwhile, the Academic Council, composed of the President, Vice Presidents, Deans, and academic leaders, plays a crucial role in maintaining academic quality by reviewing curricula, setting academic policies, and recommending standards for admission, retention, and graduation. Their regular meetings, structured proceedings, and active participation of members reflect a strong culture of shared governance and transparency.

The effectiveness of these councils is evident in their outputs—resolutions, policies, and recommendations that directly enhance academic and administrative operations. The Academic Council ensures that curricular offerings remain relevant and responsive to the needs of students and stakeholders, while the Administrative Council strengthens institutional systems through efficient resource allocation, operational guidelines, and administrative reforms. By fulfilling their mandated functions, both councils contribute to the University's overall effectiveness, ensuring that decisions are participatory, evidence-based, and supportive of the University's mission of providing quality, accessible, and responsive education.
