FOOTBALL PLAYERS AND MANAGERS- Please stop in the office to pick up your banquet letter.

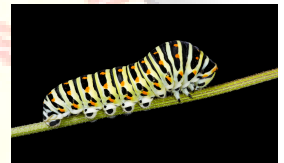
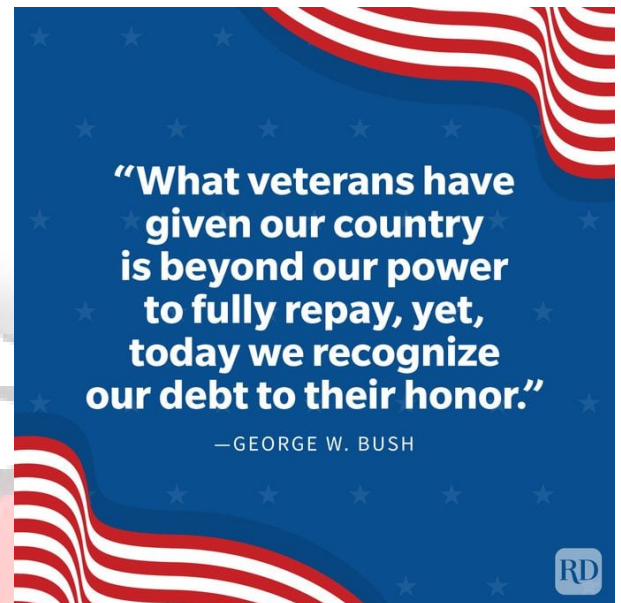

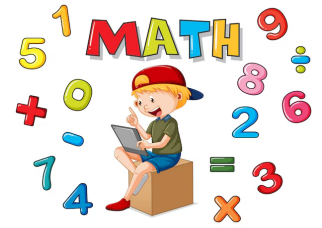
