

Adding Qwickly Attendance Course Link to Course Navigation

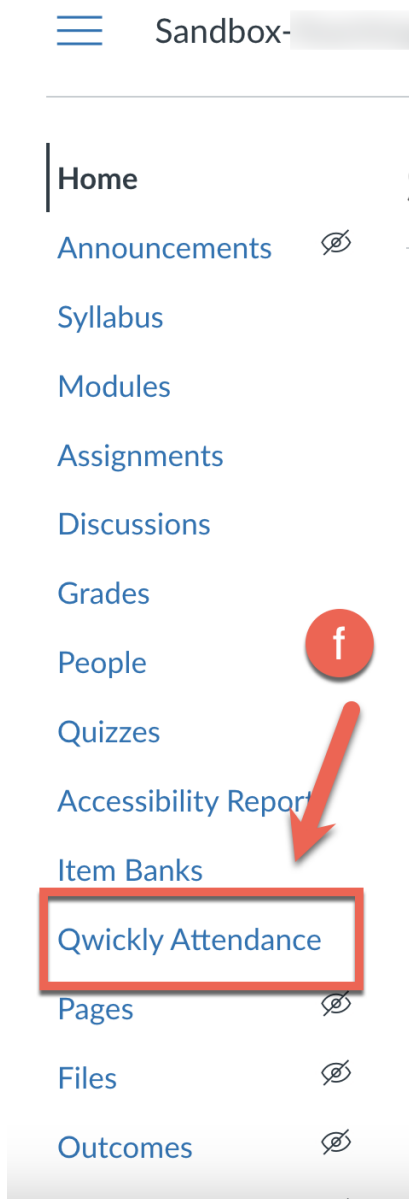
- Go to your Canvas dashboard and locate a sandbox course to add the link to.
- Once in the desired course, on the left-side navigation, click on "Settings"(a), then find the "Navigation" tab(b).
- Locate the Qwickly Attendance tool, under the disabled link section, click on the three dots(c), then click "Enable"(d).
