



Michigan Bronco Club Membership Program Questions and Answers

Q: What are the Membership Program tier prices?

A: The Premium Membership is \$75, the Elite Membership is \$50, and the Basic Membership will remain free. A spouse “add-on” is available for \$25. For youth, there is a NexGen option for \$10.

Q: What do I get for my membership and where does the money cover?

A: With the Premium Membership, \$40 goes to cover the partner membership with Great Lakes Four Wheel Drive Association (GLFWDA). This includes liability insurance for sponsored events, access to trail maintenance equipment, advocacy for full-size off-roading, and other benefits.

Both paid membership levels include an annual swag bag with level-specific gear, early access to sign-ups, level-specific discount in the merch store, and voting rights in annual elections. All Board Members and Team Leaders will hold a Premium Membership.

Remaining monies will support operating costs of Michigan Bronco Club (MBC) to include annual fees to the federal and state governments, website hosting, vendor costs, equipment, insurance, event fees, etc. Please review monthly Treasurer report for more detailed information on how we manage finances.

Q: Why is there a paid Member Only ride? Does this violate the No Segregation rule?

A: Over the years, we’ve had several opportunities where an idea to get together and ride comes up through the Board meeting and is not presented in the Facebook group. This being listed is, simply, formally listing these less organized opportunities. Nothing is changing for events or Club-sponsored rides.

We do not believe this violates the No Segregation rule as we are not segregating who can be a member - membership is available to all Bronco models, model years, driver skill levels, and any people groups we can list.



Q: What does the liability insurance cover?

A: We are, still, gathering information about all the particulars of the policy coverage to better articulate coverage basics. In a nutshell, if injury is caused during a sponsored event, you are covered under the liability insurance for the caused injury. In addition to events, we are covered on all trail maintenance activities.

Q: How does this affect my current GLFWDA membership?

A: The current plan is to move existing renewal dates to January 1, to coincide with MBC renewals. We are working with GLFWDA on this topic to keep members whole and minimize payment overlap. Members will keep their current GLFWDA member numbers. We will work with people, as needed, for case-by-case situations.

Q: How will the merch store discount work?

A: As we create MBC Member Numbers, we will add those numbers to the discount code list. Members will enter their member number into the Discount Code field and the discount for their level will be applied.
