Spring clean up

- Suggested dates
 - Earth Day (April 22nd)
 - Just prior to 8th grade promotion day
 - 21st of May was suggested by Dr. McKey and seconded by Tania
- Mr. Riser talked to kids about cleaning up our community
- Two different classrooms have signed up to do 15 minute service breaks + during lunch time kids are cleaning stuff up.
- More mulch is needed + power washing is still needed

Teacher Appreciation Week

- May 2nd to the 6th
- Dr. McKey will check in with staff to see whether they're open to homemade items or would prefer store bought only
- Historically: one day of breakfast foods, one day of supported lunch,
 one day staff prize raffle + cookies + desserts

PTO leadership positions

- Both the Treasurer and President roles need to be filled before the end of this school year, to ensure time for a scaffolded transition

School Readerboard

- Lori Lachman (former OGMS parent) and Terri Johnson (PPS contact for both readerboard and gate) report that a permit has been obtained from the city; Current status: waiting to receive copy of the report from city and a land survey before continuing with installation
- Time and expertise are donated; all hoops have been jumped through
- Lori has alist of engineers, landscape architects, and all the other people who've donated time and money, including the Arlo Apartments which donated \$10,000.

Volunteer Update

- There were 5 responses on volunteer survey
 - Respondents wanted to help out by being positive presence in hallways and also to volunteer at the Clothing Closet
- One parent suggested updating the volunteer survey to increase response rate

Clothing Closet

- More volunteers are needed
- SUN has a new family coordinator and they may be helping with the clothing closet
- Clothing closet will move to the current Health Office later this year.
 There's already shelving in Health room

Principal Update

- New Principal and addition Assistant Principal for 2022/23 school year
 - PPS will send out information about hiring a new OGMS principal once they have a panel of candidates, possibly in mid April.

 There are no candidates at this time
 - This year, OGMS has an Assistant Principal and a half time site administrator. There will be two Assistant Principals in the building next year (one new + one returning)
 - Assistant Principal interviews will take place after a principal has been hired.
 - There have been no official updates from PPS on this process since January
 - Jefferson high school is also seeking candidates for the position of Principal for 2022/23
- Dr McKey is in classrooms one or two periods (out of 4) per day.
 Having more volunteers on hand would would enable her to redirect more of her time back into duties more directly related to her position
