The vineyard also offers wine and cheese pairings, a great way to submerge yourself in the experience.

Third, **Priam Vineyards** has been around since 1978 and is located on one of the highest points in town. With over 140 vineyards, the winery produces estate-grown, certified organic wines, including dry reds and semi-dry whites. They host various events, including live music and food tastings.

Fourth on our list is **White Birch Winery**. Locally owned and operated, this charming winery offers a selection of bold and flavorful wines. Their reds and whites are made exclusively from estate-grown grapes, and their tasting room also provides several gourmet food items, such as cheese and crackers.

Fifth is **Chamard Vineyards**. Located in Clinton, this vineyard offers a range of red and white wines, both dry and sweet. They are well-known for their Bordeaux-style reds, which feature flavors such as blackberry and plum. The vineyard also hosts private parties and wedding receptions and provides tastings for those traveling through the area.

Sixth is **Jonathan Edwards Winery**. Named for a famous resident of the area, this family-run business makes various wines that capture the spirit of New England. Enjoy a classic Chardonnay or Pinot Grigio, or try something a bit more unusual, like the Chambourcin or Merlot.

They also offer opportunities to tour the on-site gallery, where guests can learn more about their wine-making processes.

Eighth is **Gouveia Vineyards**. Located in Wallingford, this winery produces various luscious wines, from semi-dry and semi-sweet to unique dessert wines. They have a tasting room with indoor and outdoor seating options and host weddings and significant events.
