- CIF Bylaw 212 was reviewed, schools were asked to educate coaches and student athletes.
- The first violation is removal of the posting and return of any funds.
- The second violation is a one-year suspension.
- The third violation is removal from high school sports.
- J. Stanley asked SDUSD athletic directors to share spring timecards with their timekeeper, coach contact and folder are to be returned, and the fall emergency action plan (EAP) verification document needs to be completed and emailed to J. Stanley.

- a. 2025-26 CIF Staying the Same
 - Official Fees and CIF Dues for 2025-26
- Had moved to and are continuing with the single game structure.
- Football officials' costs are staying the same, total games needing to be moved are three compared to four or five a week so
 the recruitment of the officials is appreciated.
- Thank you also to Morse High School who helped with the move.
 - ii. Playoff Specific Balls
- Remaining consistent with playoff balls.
- NFHS stamped balls are allowed to be used during the season but playoff balls must be used.
- State CIF and Local CIF contracts are different, meaning the State CIF ball could be different but Local CIF provides a ball for
 use.
- Ball contract renegotiation is in progress.

- Don't foresee major changes.
 - b. 2025-26 and Future CIF Changes
 - i. CIF Bylaw 207 Transfer Eligibility
- Moving into year two of those discussions, had hoped to have options to start exploring.
- Unfortunately there has not been movement, now hopeful in the fall there will be some information to discuss and share feedback on.
- The earliest if it happens would be 2027-28.
 - ii. CIF Bylaw 510 Undue Influence, Pre-Enrollment Contact, Disclosing
- Not a new bylaw but at the bottom there's notes that have been added in red.
- Reminder shared to ensure use of the new 510 form as any old forms used will be sent back.
- D. Fai clarified it is the May revision version, CIF confirmed yes.
- Hope to have 2025-26 bylaws posted by August 1st.
- CIF will go into a more in depth training at the next San Diego City Conference (SDCC) meeting in September.
 - iii. CIF 2025-26 Start Dates
- All fall sports are now starting on the same date.
 - iv. State CIF 2026-27 Draft Calendar (click here)
- Asked to review this.
- See it as a positive thing, though concerns have been shared such as overlaps in winter and spring.
- Spring has been staggered as the championships need to be varied.
- The goal is to have this voted on to go into effect 2026-27.
- Athletic Directors were told to go back and review this information to plan accordingly to prevent issues.
- Bring to the next meeting any questions or concerns.
- A. Nowak shared facility availability will be an issue.
- R. Lardizabal asked why there is an earlier start date for baseball and softball with the same end date.
- J. Cavaiola asked about morning practices, which is a Board decision related to healthy late start. Need to be mindful of student access via busing. Not a CIF issue.
- N. Stevens clarified what is needed, potential ideas to assist with the discussion.
- J. Pisapia lifted up the challenges with playoffs overlapping with graduation.

- Were provided in-person.

- D. Fai clarified if already provided a valid change of residence only a 510 form is needed, CIF said yes.

- J. Pisapia asked how many students represent each conference, four to five is recommended.

 - h. CIF Title IX Lawsuit
- Though there is a Federal push, the State is who CIF abides by specifically Ed Code.
- Still following California law and California Education Code.
- Clarity may be provided as further discussions are had and decisions are made.
- If there are any changes they will be communicated.
- R. Lardizabal asked if Local CIF will follow State CIF's model, CIF said yes.

- A. Brooks asked if a school/CIF club team is different than a San Diego Surf team for example, CIF shared the latter as a club as there is no school/CIF jurisdiction.
- A clarifying question asked if a school's outside of season baseball team can play a club team, CIF says they could as it is club versus club but there may be district restrictions.
