

**Pleasantville Community School
Special Meeting of the Board of Education
District Office
Tuesday, December 2, 2014
5:30 p.m.**

The Pleasantville School Board met in special session on December 2, 2014 at 5:30 P.M. in the District Office. Present: Ray, Padellford, Danks, and DeJoode. Jeff Krausman, legal counsel for the school, along with Principal Friday, Superintendent Aylsworth and Bd. Secretary Friday and the grandparent of the student in question and a guest of their family was also present.

5:30 p.m. President Padellford called the meeting to order.

Motion made by DeJoode and seconded by Ray to approve the consent agenda with addition of one personnel item under new business. Motion carried (4-0).

Motion made by DeJoode and seconded by Danks to approve bill from Bob Gripp for masonry work at Elementary. Motion carried (4-0).

Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to move into closed session pursuant to Chapter 21.5(1)(e) of the Iowa Code to conduct a hearing to either suspend or expel a student as requested by the family of the student. Roll call vote: Ray-aye, Danks-aye, DeJoode-aye, Padellford-aye. Motion carried (4-0).

5:33 p.m. The Board moved into closed session.

5:55 p.m. The Board returned to open session.

Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to approve the following: The recommendation of the Administration to expel the student identified in the closed session adopted. The student is expelled for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year. During the period of expulsion the following conditions apply:

1. The student shall receive a mental health assessment and shall follow through with all recommendations of the service provider. Proof of compliance with this requirement shall be in writing and submitted to the Superintendent at 415 Jones Street, Pleasantville, Iowa.
2. The student shall not be allowed on any property of the Pleasantville Community School District unless prior arrangements have been made with the Superintendent. If found on school property without permission it shall be considered trespassing and may result in arrest.
3. To be reinstated the student will complete the above requirements and the student or guardian must notify the Superintendent at (515)848-0555. School placement conditions will be determined by the Administration at that time.
4. The Superintendent is encouraged to assist the student in finding alternative education opportunities during the period of expulsion.

It is further moved the Board President issue a written decision consistent to the Board's findings and decision to be provided to the student. Motion carried (4-0).

Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to approve the contracts of Craig Southall-Asst Wrestling and Sheldon Card-Asst JH Wrestling with appropriate placement on salary schedule. Motion carried (4-0).

Motion made by DeJoode and seconded by Danks to accept the resignation of Frank Vanderpool-Industrial Tech effective December 19, 2014. Motion carried (4-0).

Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to adjourn. Motion carried (4-0).
