Course Description:

Remind App:

I use a free texting program in all my classes and clubs to share reminders about upcoming tests, projects, quizzes, and homework. Students can reply if they need help, and all messages are recorded without sharing phone numbers. It's also a great way for parents to contact me and help students stay prepared. The app is available for all devices—just be sure your phone plan includes texting.

How to sign up?

1. In your text messaging app create a new text to the number: **81010**
2. In the text message type the exact following code: **@bhsenvscia**
3. Follow any other instructions that may be received by a text. If you have already signed up for Remind101 in the past you should not have any other steps to complete signing up.
4. Alternatively, you can download the Remind app and set up an account and enter the same codes as above without the @ symbol.
